Dear Justice Partners:

As a result of the unprecedented statewide fiscal crisis and judicial branch budget reductions, the Judicial Council has designated the third Wednesday of each month from September 2009 through June 2010 as court closure days under Government Code section 68106. All Superior Courts, the Courts of Appeal, and the Supreme Court will be closed for the transaction of judicial business on these dates, **beginning September 16, 2009.**

The Superior Court of California, County of San Francisco, remains committed to working with our justice partners to reduce the impact of these closures on the public and the legal community as much as possible. This letter is intended to provide information to help you schedule Court-related matters.

The following list of closure days will be treated as Court holidays for the purposes of scheduling hearings and calculating filing deadlines. Matters already calendared for hearing on a scheduled court closure day will be rescheduled and the parties will receive notice of a new date. Here is the list of closure days:
